

## 3-D Pop-up Card

### *Supplies*

1 piece of 4 1/4" x 11" cardstock for the card base (see the scoring/cutting template)

1 piece 4 3/4" x 3" cardstock for the pop-up part of the card

1 piece 1 1/4" x 3 1/4" cardstock in the same color as the pop-up part of the card

1 piece 4 1/2" x 2 3/4" in white/light-colored cardstock to stamp your image that is on the pop-up part of the card

1 piece 1" x 3" white/light-colored cardstock for your word stamp

2 Eyelets (optional)—if using eyelets you also need a 1/8" paper punch and eyelet setter

Stamp to fit on the 2 3/4" x 4 1/2" white/light-colored cardstock

Corresponding stamp to fit on the 1" x 3" white/light-colored cardstock

Paper cutter with scoring blade

Versamark pad

Selected ink pad(s) for stamping your main image and word(s) or greeting

Double-stick tape

## Step by Step

### *Preparing the Base Piece:*



1. Slide your 4 1/4" x 11" cardstock into the paper cutter horizontally.

**Note:** See the scoring/cutting template below for the score and cut lines on this piece.



2. Line up the end of cardstock and score at the 1", 2 3/4", 3 3/4" and 5 1/2" mark.



3. Put the other end of the cardstock into the paper cutter and score at the 1", 2 3/4", and 3 3/4" mark.



4. At the 5 1/2" score line cut leaving 1/2" from each edge uncut on each side (see scoring/cutting template below).



5. Stamp the base with a stamp that complements your selected main image (e.g., if you stamp a snowman you can use a snowflake stamp) using a Versamark pad.

**Note:** If you use a directional stamp to stamp the base, make sure that when you stamp that you stamp up towards to the 5 1/2" score line so that your stamp image is right-side up when the card is flat.



Stamp one side of the base stamping up towards the center fold at the 5 1/2" mark.



Stamp the other side of the base stamping up towards the center fold at the 5 1/2" mark.

*Stamping the Main Image and Word(s) or Greeting:*



1. Stamp your image on the 4 1/2" x 2 3/4" piece of white/light-colored cardstock and color (if needed as desired).



**Note:** Make sure that you stamp the image a little higher up since the bottom inch of the pop-up piece of the card will be covered by the base.



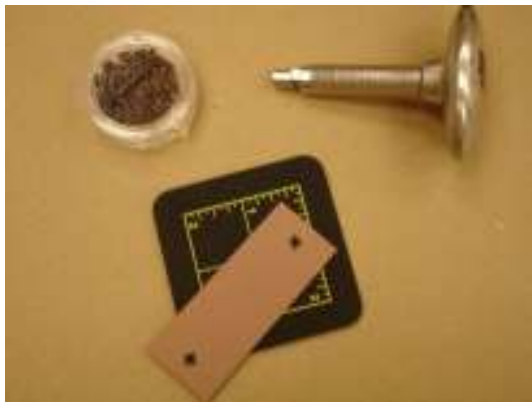
2. Attach your image to the 4 3/4" x 3" piece of cardstock.



3. Stamp your selected word(s) or greeting on the 1" x 3" piece of white/light-colored cardstock.



4. Attach your stamped word(s) or greeting to the 1 1/4" x 3 1/4" piece of cardstock.

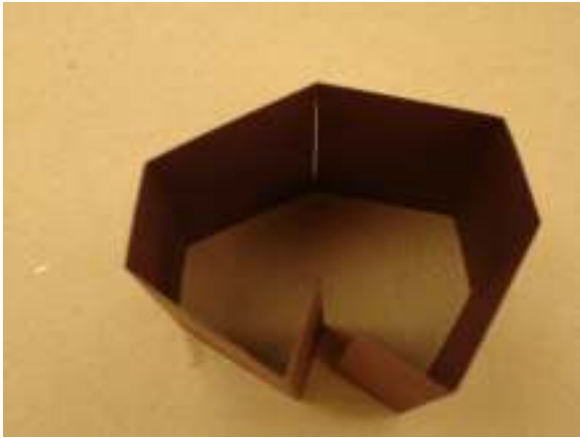


5. If desired, punch holes on each side of the word(s) or greeting and set an eyelet on each side.

*Completing the Card:*



1. Apply double-stick tape to the back of the 1 1/4" x 3 1/4" piece of cardstock and attach it to the base between the 2 3/4" and 3 3/4" score lines, making sure the top of the words face the 5 1/2" score line (see Card Completion diagram below)



2. Fold the card at all of the score lines.

3. Apply double stick tape to the front of the card between the zero and 1" mark on each side.



4. Insert your image (right-side up) in the slit at the 5 1/2" score line so that 1" of the image is below the slit line.



5. Bring each end of the base towards the image and attach each end to the image so that the bottom of the card looks like a base.



6. To mail the card gently put your fingers into the base of the card on each side of the bottom of the image and pull the slit up to the top. A small part of the image should show.
